As the lines represent the strings of the guitar

Zero (0) represents open strings

Numbers represents frets

Cross (X) represents muted strings

Reprise signs at the beginning and end of the bar

1. Alternate ending (1st time)

2. Alternate ending (2nd time)

Fermata (prolonged time duration)

Accented note

Note with staccato

Palm muted notes

Vibrato

Natural harmonic

Artificial harmonic

Bend (half step)

Bend (whole step)

Tie note (connecting of two notes)

Hammer-on (legato)

Pull-off (legato)

Hammer-on and pull-off (legato)

Brush downstroke (using thumb)
